There were TAA Foundation Members (ex RAAF'ies who joined TAA after being discharged) at the very start of the airline attending (Lance Irwin, Len Edgar, Ray 'Bluey' Kennedy, John Grant, Col O'Brien and George Wren); and even a passenger from the first flight – none other than Nancy Duncan (daughter of Sir Arthur Coles – who was Chairman of the Australian National Airlines Commission). Nancy told us "our family and I feel very privileged to be invited to your 66th Birthday celebration. As our troops were coming home after the War it was a unique time in our history for the Federal Government to start a national airline. The talented group of men who were able to make this happen would be very proud of your achievement in making this Museum a reality.
