The Museum recently had a visit from Neil Macmillan [son of TAA pilot James Macmillan] enquiring whether we would be interested in the christening scissors used by Lady Chippindall [Neil's grandmother] when TAA's first Boeing B727 T-Jet (James Cook) arrived in Melbourne on 16 October 1964.

We assured Neil we would take good care of the christening scissors [see picture below], which are now on display at the Museum. Thanks Neil.
